PREAMBLE: Bwiza Foundation is brainchild of a Ugandan couple - Resty Kagabani (midwife) and Innocent Tumuheki (Medical Clinical Officer). It started in 2001 as a Community-Based Organization *Rwebisengo Maternal ChildCare Centre (CBO#130, in Ntoroko District)*, birthed a clinic (2001), church (2014), demo farm (2015), a secondary school (2022) and upgraded into *Bwiza Foundation (Non-Government Organisation)* in 2025 to scale operations nationwide.

Bwiza Foundation is found in Western Uganda, Ntoroko district, Rwebisengo Town Council; a district that is inhabited by cattle keepers (Batuku) and Refugees (mostly Congolese). It is in the rift valley and is usually affected by floods in the rainy season, bridges are broken and the roads become impassable making it difficult for vehicles and people to reach; it also experiences a prolonged dry spell hence rampant food shortages and massive cattle death.

We envision a world where rural people are happy and healthy like in paradise. We do this by (our mission) building beautiful interventions that address local community problems. Our core values are (BWIZA): Bravery, Welcoming, Integrity, Zealous, Achievers. **Bwiza** translates to “physical beauty, moral goodness, general quality of being pleasant or desirable”.

BWIZA's MENU OF SERVICE DELIVERY PROGRAMMES

School@5: Paradise Model Secondary School - Ntoroko (Sep 2022) | worth US\$30k



Paradise Model Schools was envisioned in 2013 and implemented in Sep 2022 as a Secondary School: mixed, Christian-founded, boarding and day. We started with 15 students in Feb 2023 but now we have 13 staff and 97 students in Senior 1 – 4. The school is worth US\$30,000 comprising 3.5 acres, 4 Classroom blocks, Administration block, 3.5 acres of land and Furniture. The School requires @USD100k to cover classroom block, dormitory, library, and computers.

Farm@10: Paradise Model Farm, Rwebisengo (Dec 2015) | worth US\$100k

The school demo farm started in 2015 on a 2 acre land with 20 goats. It has graduated into a demo farm on 200 acre land to supply the school needs of vegetable, beans and maize. It is now worth \$100,000 and plan for a solar irrigation system, dairy cow barn and greenhouse. We are hosting 15 farming families in a sort of communal irrigation scheme; we're ranked #2 model farm in Ntoroko.

Church@11: God's Glory Church - Ntoroko (2014) | worth US\$10k

GGC does soul winning through evangelism and hands-on to improve livelihoods. It opened Bwiza Praise and Worship Band. It is worth \$10,000 and plans for sound equipment, building.



Clinic@24: Rwebisengo Maternal ChildCare Centre Clinic, Ntoroko (2001 Jan) | worth US\$50k

Rwebisengo Maternal ChildCare Centre Clinic/RMCC Clinic is a private Health Centre II/ Maternity Centre opened in 2001 under the CBO #130 (RMCC registered in 2001 in then Bundibugyo). It offers a 24/7 out-patient and in-patient care to locals and neighbors from Democratic Republic of Congo. It has 11 staff and serves 200 patients per week including 2 deliveries per week.
